Shop Watch - Update

Useful Advice From Our Police : What to Do, What To Report

If you are a Member of Tetbury Shop Watch, we ask that should you witness an incident that you believe to be of a suspicious nature or indeed criminal, that you proceed along the following guidelines.



Examples of incidents that you may wish to use Tetbury Shop Watch for include; a suspicious person in your shop, someone using a fake note, a suspicious telephone call or you later find that an item has been stolen. We all have that gut feeling when something isn't right and these are the times to use the scheme to protect both yourself and other Businesses within Tetbury.

Should one of the above (or similar) suspicious incidents occur, then please as soon as viable and possible, call **0845 090 1234** (The Police Contact Centre), stating when your call is picked up, that you are a Shop Watch Member and then go on to give a description of what has happened, giving as much detail about the persons involved as possible, such as; Sex, Colour, Age, Build, Clothing, Height, Hair and anything else that is memorable. Also, if safe to do so, give the direction of travel, details of any vehicles or indeed other people that appear to be with them.

If you are a Member of the scheme, please also start the **Ring Round** by calling both the Close Hotel and Snooty Fox, along with any other Business contacts that you are responsible for passing the message along to. Once it has been logged as an incident by the Police Control Room, a 'Watch Word' message will be sent out to all other members via telephone and the follow-up on the incident will then be undertaken by an available Police Officer.

If a crime is being (or you believe is being) committed, then please continue to contact the Police via the **999** system. Amongst the above steps it will be beneficial to mention the full description of the person/s involved and what is happening. Once again, a 'Shop Watch' message will be sent out to warn other Members, alongside the Police response.
