#### Sir William Romney's School : Headmaster Steven Mackay on The 2010 GCSE Results...



All of us at the School are really pleased by the GCSE results this year and they are the best results that the School has achieved. The 5+ A\*-C pass rate of 75% is a 16% improvement from last year, the pass rate 5+ A\*-C pass rate (including English and Maths) was 9% higher - both of these a tremendous achievement. I am very proud of our students and on results day was delighted to see so many of our students

attain at such a high level and gain entry to their College or Sixth Form of choice. It was particularly satisfying to see so many A\* and A grades, with 12 students gaining 8 or more A\* and A grades. It has given me great pleasure to see this group meet and, in many cases, exceed their potential and is a testament to the high quality of teaching, guidance and support at the School as well as the hard work of the students throughout the 2 years of study in their GCSE courses.

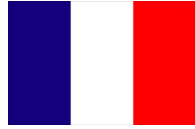
