Tetbury Food and Drink Festival – coming in September

Now in its fifth year, The Tetbury Food & Drink Festival is attracting a growing number of local food and drink related businesses. From bakeries to cheese and honey makers, vineyards and farms, smokehouses and mills - all coming together to celebrate the very best food and drink that our wonderful and fruitful area has to offer.

Amongst the highpoints of our festival is the market on Sunday 25th September. With over forty stalls there is something for everyone, with a wide range of food and drink on display. During the day there will be demonstrations from celebrated chefs, writers and others, including sausage making, butchery and bread making. To add to the fun of the day will be good old fashioned entertainment from Morris dancers and a Brass Band.

Other highlights this year include tours of the Duchy Home Farm, Shipton Mill and Bow in the Cloud vineyard - these proved a real success last year and so are back by popular demand. We are awaiting final confirmation from Highgrove the home of TRH The Prince of Wales and Duchess of Cornwall what they will be organising, but a tour of the beautiful gardens will be combined with a gastronomic delight guaranteed to please. Rob Rees, The Cotswold Chef is holding a special cookery Demonstration and Lunch at the Cotswold Chef Centre (01285 656813) and there is the opportunity to learn the traditional art of cheese making with Melissa Ravenhill at The Woelfuldane in Minchinhampton (07966 088225).

There will be a special launch party featuring recipes from the book to be held on the Saturday 24th with wines chosen and presented by Jackie Barr of Oxford Wines at The Close Hotel in Long Street Tetbury (01666 502272) and everything kicks off with a gathering of the Gloucestershire Old Spot Sausage Appreciation Society Dinner also at The Close Hotel on the Wednesday 21st September.
